We are convinced that this is exactly the key to solving our problems of the Catholic Church in Germany. The Synodal Way must focus on the implementation of the instructions from Rome and find ways to make it happen. Therefore, we repeatedly propose to also change the name of the Synodal Way to “Way of Conversion and New Evangelization” as well as to add people who are already successfully walking this way (like James Mallon from Canada or Stift Heiligenkreuz in Austria) to the cast.

In addition, every Catholic should be very concerned about the cohesion in the universal Church, which has been realized for millennia through unity with the Pope. We are convinced that a sharpening of the Catholic profile and a clear proclamation of Catholic doctrine are the way to new growth.

We would be pleased if the path of conversion and new evangelization would begin with the bishops in Germany, reconsidering (remembering their promise of consecration) their statements on the Pope's letter, and especially taking to heart Pope Francis' advice to invoke Mary, the Mother of Evangelization. In a public act of contrition and penance, the DBK could consecrate our entire country to Mary, so that as many people as possible may convert to and learn to love her Son.
